

REGISTERED VOTERS BY AGE GROUP AND PARTY





The ExpressVote is a universal voting system designed for use by all voters, especially those who are unable to mark their ballot in their own. Voters can use the touchscreen to make their ballot choices. Headphones and a tactile keypad are available for voters who require an audio ballot.


The DS200 Ballot Scanner system is an electronic voting system that uses an optical scanner to read marked paper ballots and tally the results. This system allows for paper ballots to be immediately tabulated at the polling site and notifies voters of any marking errors.



213 EVID

The EViD system is a network of electronic devices at voting sites communicating with each other and with the county's voter registration system. The electronic devices —EViD stations —allow poll workers to quickly check in voters during early voting and on Election Day.

ELECTION DAY PRECINCT TEAMS

CLERK

The Clerk supervises the polling location, resolves voter issues and reconciles ballot totals.

BALLOT ISSUER

The Ballot Issuer collects voting passes from voters and issues ballots.



EVID OPERATOR

The EVID Operator operates the electronic poll book, confirms voter eligibility and signature, and issues voting passes.

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

The Equipment Operator sets up and assists voters with ballot marking and ballot tabulation equipment.

POLL DEPUTY

The Poll Deputy ensures order outside the polling location, assists voters with entry, and maintains the "no solicitation zone".

VOTE

STANDBY

Standby election workers fill Election Day vacancies as needed. They receive training for all support staff positions and are a critical component of elections.

EVID SUPERVISOR

The EVID Supervisor assists the Clerk in managing polling locations and completing tasks.



VOTER TURNOUT BY AGE GROUP AND PARTY






